MATTERS ARISING

- 185/1/18 HOLY TRINITY CHURCH-YARD EXTENSION Councillors' agreed that a follow up letter should be sent to Tarmac seeking a firm response to our letter of May 2016.
- 186/1/18 CONTRACTS OF EMPLOYMENT Due to un-foreseen circumstances Clerk has not yet contacted similar sized Parishes, but the matter will be progressed.
- 187/1/18 TREE ROOTS DCC will be attending to the tree roots on the footpath at Hill Green & the village green near to the stocks.
- 188/1/18 STREET LIGHTING Complaints of lights not on or on all day Wormhill, Clerk to deal with.
- 189/1/18 BRIDLE PATH SIGN Councillors' expressed concern over it's condition. Clerk confirmed that DCC have agreed to give this matter their attention.
- 190/1/18 GREAT ROCKS BUS SHELTER Chair, Vice Chair & the handyman have attended a site meeting with an Officer from DCC Transport Dept. Good results Councillors', were pleased DCC Officer has agreed to give this matter priority. They will clear the site, re-site a toughened glazed unit to our specification with lighting, alter the kerb for easier access on & off the bus .The new shelter will hopefully be started April/May 2018 & our share of the total cost will be in region of £3,000. Clerk to complete necessary paperwork with DCC & he will notify residents at 1 & 3 Bathamgate Road of this proposed bus shelter alteration.
- 91/1/18 CAR PARKING MEADOW AVENUE Awaiting the results of County Coun. Mrs Grooby's Contact with HPBC.

- 93/1/18 HGV's BATHAMGATE ROAD Reply from DCC states it is the Police or Trading Standards who enforce weight restrictions: it would appear we are being past from pillar to post. However, we have been given the name of a DCC Officer who's remit this problem should come under—Clerk to write to him giving all the facts . This follows further observations of HGV's using the weight restricted part of this road.

CORRESPONDENCE

- 201/1/18 PLANNING Code CW1/0817/46 & Code CW1/1213/140 for Barry Wood Plant Hire Ltd. seeking permission to allow the continuation of recycling operations at Victory Quarry for a further period of ten years. DCC have issued a refusal notice stating it would be contrary Policy S2 of the High Peak Local Plan.
- 202/1/18 PLANNING Code HPK/2017/0558 being Energy Reserve Facility, Waterswallows Industrial Park, STOR POWER LTD. Clerk confirmed he had written to HPBC with the reason for our refusal of this Planning Application.
- 203/1/18 PLANNING Code HPK/2017/0673 for Nestle Waters, Ltd., Waterswallows Lane, Green Fairfield, SK17 7JD. Being an extension to existing bottling plant & distribution facility. Councillors' viewed these plans & asked the Clerk to place on record that they had no objections to this proposed development, but questioned the likelihood of a further 72 new employees & whether this employment would be sourced locally. In addition we should highlight to HPBC the continued failure to up-date infrastructure such as footpaths, cycle lanes, & adequate highway lighting. These are important issues for this location which have previously been brought to the attention of the local authority by this Council for this area.
