

**THE DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

**(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2022**

Derbyshire County Council hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be, in respects of roads in the District of Derbyshire Dales:

**No waiting At Any Time**

**Millers Dale**

**Un-named Road leading to Glebe Farm**

**Both sides**

From its junction with the B6049 for a distance of 363 metres in a north-easterly direction.

**B6049**

**North side**

From its junction with the un-named road leading to Glebe Farm in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 15 metres.

**South side**

From a point 42 metres south-west of its junction with the un-named road leading to Glebe Farm in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 63 metres.
